- 3. Matters arising from previous minutes
  - 3.1 Committee Meetings and Practise Session Venue: The trial meeting at the St. Olaf Lodge Hall has been put on hold until further notice, committee meetings will continue to be held in the Killie.

## 4. New Business

4.1 Scottish Week Concert: More information is required from Liz regarding the Date, Time and requirement from the Folk Club. Action ....Liz

It is proposed to have individual performances from Club Members including the choir rather than one group as last year.

**4.2 Skip Gorman**: The concert with Skip is planned for Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> July in the Dining Room at the Killie, a small stage will be erected at the fireplace for the event and it will be an all ticket event.

Tickets will be £5 per Adult (this includes a free strip of raffle tickets worth £1 collected at the door on production of a ticket) and £2 for Kids accompanied by an Adult.



**4.3 Review of March Folk Night:** A Bob Dylan night to remember with a large audience enjoying a tribute to the master. The choir once again were brilliant with their rendition of "Blowing in the Wind."

The restrictions imposed by the size and layout of the lounge along with the sound problems in the room were discussed at length and a unanimous decision taken that the Folk Club should move into the Killie Dining Room from October to May (when the requirement for meals from hotel guests would be reduced from the summer months) This would give much more space for performers, guests, and audience alike and a far better session with more of the audience involved. This has still to be finalised with Martin and Lucy but they had agreed in principal to the planned move.

**4.4 Hand Drumming Workshop:** It was agreed by Angus to host a hand drumming workshop at the Village Hall, there are spare drums available but as many of us have a

drum or two at home there should be enough to go round. Arrangements to be finalised Action ....Angus

4.5 Fish Festival: More details were given by the committee members who attended the Harbour Committee meeting at the St.Olaf Hotel, The Saturday evening event will run from 07:30 until Midnight with two breaks, one for stovies and one for the fireworks. The P.A. system can be set up from 11:0-clock on the Saturday morning and the Harbour Committee have requested use of the P.A during the day.

There appears to be confusion as to the type of event to be held in the marquee at the harbour on the Saturday night, if it is a seated concert or a ceilidh. Liz to be contacted to advice prior to finalising performers. Action... Liz

Scott to contact Andy Clucas regarding the Oxbow Lake sound Engineer to see if he could do the sound on the day ( Expenses agreed were £50 ) using our equipment to keep the costs down as the hire of a van to bring his own equipment would be around £300. Action ... Scott
