

CRUDEN BAY FOLK CLUB MEETING MINUTES

- 3.3: Recording of Folk Night for Posterity: Angus has recorded the July Folk Night and made up CD,s which were passed on to the Committee at the meeting, this was considered as a very good way to have a library of the Folk Nights. A big thank you to Angus for the time spent in preparing this and for future recordings.

- 3.4: <u>Aberdeen Choir (Male -Voice)</u>: Planned for the November Folk Night, which would be 2×20 minute sets or a 45 minute set, on the expenses front, it was agreed that a donation to the choir funds from the Folk Club would be acceptable, Brian to check availability of the choir for November...Action Brian.

- 3.6: <u>Stonehaven Folk Festival Club Visit</u>: Tansy is going to search out information on Hotels, B&B's, and the like for the first weekend in July 2018, the first concert starts on Thursday 5th July...Action Tansy.

4. New Business
