Tansy had already received a quote for an insurance policy as shown below:-

Folk Club protected up to £1,000.000Excess £250Committee Members protected up to £100,000Excess £250For both above Annual Cost £90.72Folk Club Equipment out with the Hotel £2,000Annual Cost £30.63Folk Club Equipment is the Hotel Hotel £2,000

Folk Club Equipment in the Hotel may be covered by the Hotel Insurance to be checked with Martin.
