Yvonne as Chairperson welcomed everyone to the meeting especially our new committee member Beryl and then began the agenda.

3. <u>Minutes</u>: The minutes from the October 2019 meeting were read and accepted by all.

Matters arising from previous minutes

- 3.2 Folk Club P.A. System: Scott advised the committee on the Behringer B205D Eurolive 150watt Speaker which was recommended by John Slaven. The cost of each speaker would be £103. They will fit on to our existing speaker stands with adaptors which fit to the end on the stands at £50 each. (£17.50 carriage as they come from the states) It was unanimously agreed that we should purchase the speakers to lighten the load when setting up the P.A. system.
- 3.3 <u>Folk Club Website</u>: The recommendation from Gordon is to retain the website, as it contains quite an amount of historical information and videos of the Folk Club activities over the past 5 years and that he will make the site more "user friendly" with a direct link to the Folk Club Facebook Page. - 3.5 <u>Slains Primary School (P5-P7) Song Workshop:</u> Conor Meehan who teaches Primary 5-7 at Slains Primary School came along to the meeting to discuss the Folk Club taking part in the "Author in Residence" program at the school. It was agreed that the song "Cruden Water" would be the subject which would involve Lyrics, Recording, Musicality and hopefully getting the kids to sing the song along with the Folk Club.
