# FEBRUARY and MARCH 2025 MEETING MINUTES

Angelika as Chairperson welcomed everyone to the meeting and began the agenda.

<u>3</u> <u>Minutes</u>: The minutes from the Joint December 2024 and January 2025 Committee Meeting held on ZOOM on Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> January 2025 were read and accepted by all.

### Matters arising from previous minutes

- 3.1 <u>Guitar Workshop</u>: Awaiting further information regarding the availability of the Guitar Tutor to facilitate the workshop. Mike to check with Yvonne as to any progress...Action Mike.
- **3.2** <u>Folk Club's Annual Charity Donation</u>: Awaiting further information and contact details from Joe regarding the group that teach children to play musical instruments, Brian and Gordon both agreed that perhaps the group could be persuaded to facilitate a workshop in the Village Hall, thereby supporting both the Hall and Community. Joe to supply details of the group to the Committee to progress this further....Action Joe.

**3.3** Folk night with the Fiere Deems and Silver City Singers: Brian informed the Committee that, to make the trip worthwhile for the singers, they would prefer a longer spot on the night. All agreed that a 40 minute spot could be planned into the night's running order. Brian to convey this to the singers and find out what dates they can give us for the performance...Action Brian.

#### 4.0 New Business:

4.1 <u>Review of the January Folk Night on Friday 31st January</u>: Another great night of music to celebrate the bard along with the mixture of musical genres that the Folk Club pride ourselves on, and of course the magnificent rendering of the classic "Tam-O-Shanter by our very own Gordon Mackay.





- **4.3** <u>New Mixing Desk and Cabling</u>: The new desk and cabling worked very well on the Folk Night in February and the extra technology on the new system allowed quicker changeovers and a better quality of sound. Gordon has given training on the desk operation to a few of the Folk Club as he will miss the next couple of Folk Nights.
- **4.4** <u>Unplugged Sessions</u> :- The impromptu Folk Club sessions in the Killie Foyer are working well, Gordon has set up a Whats-App page for the sessions.
- 4.5 <u>Annual General Meeting for year 2024</u> :- The Folk Cub Finance Books have now been fully audited by Dawn. All agreed on a date and venue which would be the 16<sup>th</sup> April in the Cruden Bay Village Hall, there would be a short Committee meeting first to discuss

the May Concert details at 7pm then the A.G.M. starting at 7:30 pm. Gordon to check with Rosemary and book the hall......Action Gordon. Update; Unfortunately the hall is booked for that evening further discussions for a date are ongoing.

Gordon to send out invites for the A.G.M. to the list of Folk Club subscribers and on the club's Website and Facebook Page.......Action Gordon.

- **4.6** The Benefit Concert for Cruden Bay Hall Funds 16<sup>th</sup> May 2025 :- Gordon advised the Committee that the ticket sales require a boost , all agreed to promote the ticket sales where possible :-
  - Concert tickets to be on sale at the Folk Night. Janet has given Eulyn spare tickets For the 28<sup>th</sup> March.
  - 2) It was agreed to raffle a pair of tickets at the Folk Night.
  - 3) Janet has offered to contact Rosemary in regard to Rosemary E-Mailing the members of the Community Association to assist in the boost for ticket sales....Action Janet.

<u>Filming of the concert</u> :- Gordon is awaiting Steven Sangster (Apex Church Peterhead), who has volunteered to film the concert for the Folk Club, to reply to Gordons E-Mail in which the requirements of the filming are detailed.

<u>Stage Lighting and Backdrop</u>:-Gordon to contact Peter Abenhiemer who has already offered to istall and operate the lighting as he does this for the yearly pantomimes. ..Action Gordon.

<u>Speakers</u>: - Gordon has suggested using the original larger speaker that the Folk Club still have to give a fuller sound along with the smaller speakers as stage monitors.

Janet has offered to take over the post of Vice Chairperson and it is hoped that Eulyn might take over as Treasurer.
